ALL Participants, Families, and Spectators of MAL Basketball

We all are looking forward to another exciting & fun MAL basketball and in-door soccer season. In order for this to happen the following gym guidelines **MUST** be followed for the 2012-13 school season. Please note the following;

1. FMS Falcons Teams may run late and cut into MAL scheduled times. FMS Falcons have priority in use of the Fieldstone Gymnasium. If these teams are still playing a game or practice, please do not disturb them. Please remain in the hallway, **quietly**, until they have finished.
2. Parents can't let their children roam **unsupervised** in the hallways or playing under the bleachers. In the past, toilets have been clogged and soap dispensers emptied. This posed a very dangerous situation for your children, as well as a distraction to the custodial staff. As a PARENT, it is your responsibility to supervise your children when visiting the schools.
3. Parents are not allowed to drop off their children **unsupervised** at the school if they don't have a game. If your child would like to watch another team's game, you must accompany them.
4. Players and spectators are required to clean up after themselves. The MAL is responsible for the cleanliness of the gyms after their use. Please place your garbage in the proper receptacles as you leave the gyms. ***Also, please note that no food or drink is permitted in the gymnasiums. The exception is that water may be provided at the team bench under the coach's supervision.**
5. **All entry and exit for night and weekend activities** at Memorial School will be from the community entrance off Memorial Drive. All entry for Fieldstone School will be from the gym entrance near the rear of the parking lot.
6. Exits must be kept free of obstructions at all times. No mats, chairs, tables, etc. may be placed across the gym rear exits, All hallway and classroom exit doors must remain unobstructed.
7. **The custodian on duty is the representative of the school district and is responsible for overseeing the building.** As such, he has the authority to make decisions concerning the safety and security of the building when emergencies arise for unusual circumstances.
8. **If school is closed due to an emergency or snow, all evening activities are cancelled.**

Failure to abide to these guidelines will give the MAL the right to issue sanction or suspension to those involved.
